DECREE

On the Introduction of a Temporary Ban on the Export from the Russian Federation of Waste and Scrap of Precious Metals or Metals Clad with Precious Metals, Other Waste and Scrap Containing Precious Metal or Precious Metal Compounds Used Mainly for the Extraction of Precious Metals

In Accordance with Articles 29 and 47 of the Treaty on the Eurasian Economic Union of May 29, 2014, Appendix No. 7 to the specified Agreement, Article 21 of the Federal Law "On the Fundamentals of State Regulation of Foreign Trade Activity" and in order to ensure the Economic Security of the Russian Federation, the Government of the Russian Federation decides:

1. Set from November 1, 2023 to April 30, 2024 including, a temporary ban on the export from the Russian Federation of waste and scrap of precious metals or metals clad with precious metals, other waste and scrap containing precious metal or precious metal compounds used mainly for the extraction of precious metals (code 7112 of the unified Commodity Nomenclature of Foreign Economic Activity of the Eurasian Economic Union), as well as waste and scrap of electrical and electronic products, used mainly for the extraction of precious metals (codes 8549 21 000 0 and 8549 29 000 0 of the unified Commodity Nomenclature of Foreign Economic Activity of the Eurasian Economic Union), which are essential for the domestic market of the Russian Federation.

The specified temporary ban applies to goods specified in the first paragraph of this article exported from the Russian Federation from November 1, 2023 and issued before November 1, 2023 in accordance with customs procedures allowing the export of goods from the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union, including goods whose customs declaration was carried out with the features provided for in Articles 115 and 116 of the Customs Code of the Eurasian Economic Union, or with the features established by the legislation of the member States of the Eurasian Economic Union on customs regulation in accordance with paragraph 8 of Article 104 of the Customs Union the Code of the Eurasian Economic Union.

This temporary ban does not apply to the export from the Russian Federation of cathode antimony in ingots, as well as samples taken from batches of waste and scrap of precious metals (code 7112 of the unified Commodity Nomenclature of Foreign Economic Activity of the Eurasian Economic Union) exported by organizations included in the list of organizations authorized to refine precious metals, approved by the decree of the Government of the Russian Federation dated August 17, 1998 No. 972 "On approval of the Working Procedure of organizations Engaged in refining of precious metals and the list of organizations authorized to refine precious metals", in order to fulfill

agreement (contractual) obligations. Meanwhile, the mass of 1 sample is no more than 500 grams in one commodity batch, regardless of the number of such batches under a foreign trade agreement (contract).

2. The Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Russian Federation, the Border Service of the Federal Security Service of the Russian Federation and the Federal Customs Service, within their competence, to ensure control over the implementation of paragraph 1 of this resolution.

3. To the Ministry of Economic Development of the Russian Federation in accordance with the established procedure:

notify the Eurasian Economic Commission on the introduction of a temporary ban specified in paragraph 1 of this resolution;

to submit for consideration by the Eurasian Economic Commission a proposal on the introduction of a temporary ban on the export of goods specified in paragraph 1 of this resolution from the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union.

4. This resolution shall enter into force from the date of its official publication.
