**Subject: Electronic issuance of A.TR movement certificates**

With the note TAXUD/1399056/24 of 16.02.2024, the Information Note No 1 of 31.03.2020 – Submission of proofs of preferential origin during the CoVid19 crisis (Doc TAXUD/2109264/20 of 31.03.2020) – has been suspended, and no longer applies as from 1 May 2024.

This implies that the note taxud.e.4(2018)7300767 on electronic issuance of movement certificates by Türkiye will be again applicable starting from 1 May 2024.

The Commission will assess the necessary legal and technical conditions for accepting electronically issued certificates bearing a QR code instead of a signature.

Until then, the Turkish authorities will issue A.TR movement certificates electronically with the signature in wet-ink.

Türkiye is requested to carry out a global regularisation of the certificates issued before and including 1 May 2024, without signature and still in transit, in the form of a communication from the Turkish authorities stating that those certificates shall be considered as endorsed and signed in wet-ink by Turkish Customs. Such communication will be circulated in CIRCABC.
